NEED HELP PAYING YOUR PHONE OR INTERNET BILL? YOU MAY QUALIFY FOR LIFELINE.



Lifeline is a federal program that helps make phone and internet service more affordable for eligible households.

WHAT LIFELINE OFFERS:

- Up to \$9.25/month off qualifying broadband or bundled service
- \$5.25/month off basic phone service
- Only one Lifeline benefit per household

WHO QUALIFIES:

- Household income at or below 135% of the federal poverty guidelines
- Or participation in Medicaid, SSI, SNAP, FPHA (Section 8), or VA Veterans Pension/Survivors Benefits

HOW TO APPLY:

- Visit www.lifelinesupport.org to check eligibility
- Contact Randolph Communications to apply your discount
- Provide proof of eligibility

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- Lifeline is available to eligible consumers regardless of race, color, national origin, or disability
- Only one Lifeline discount is allowed per household
- Taxes and fees may still apply

HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS ELIGIBLE FOR \$1,000 SCHOLARSHIPS

WHO CAN APPLY?

High school seniors who are dependents of, or subscribers with, active Randolph Communications service are eligible for the General Scholarship Program. Randolph Communications will award up to eight \$1,000 scholarships—one in each of our seven member regions and one in our non-member region. If no qualified applicants apply in a region, the scholarship committee may award unclaimed funds to another deserving applicant.

HOW ARE APPLICANTS JUDGED?

The scholarship committee evaluates applicants based on leadership in school, civic and extracurricular activities, academic achievement, and the motivation to serve and succeed.

HOW DO I APPLY?

Scholarship applications for students graduating in 2026 are available at www.rtmc.net/scholarships or obtained from the school Guidance Counselor. **Deadline is March 27, 2026.**

FRS COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP

- One-time \$2,500 scholarship for first-year college, university, or vocational-technical students
 - Sponsored by Randolph Communications (\$500) with FRS funding \$2,000
 - Encourages students to return to rural communities after completing their education

FRS NONTRADITIONAL STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

 - Salvation Army Food Distribution, Asheboro


